MarRE - Marches Renewable Energy

A grant scheme allowing eligible applicants (see below) based in the Marches to apply for a **50% grant** towards new installations of renewable technologies on their premises. Projects up to and including 200kWp (system kilowatt peak) can be supported.

Qualifying renewable technologies include:

- ✓ Wind
- ✓ Solar
- ✓ Aerothermal - including air source heat pumps
- ✓ Geothermal – including ground source heat pumps
- ✓ Hydrothermal
- ✓ Hydropower
- ✓ Biomass
- ✓ Landfill gas
- ✓ Sewage treatment plant gas and biogases

NOT eligible:

- ✗ Primary agriculture
- ✗ Domestic and residential properties
- ✗ Landlords
- ✗ New builds
- ✗ Applicants with less than a 5 year lease
- ✗ Retrospective applications
- ✗ Costs incurred before grant approval

Eligible applicants include:

- ✓ Local authorities
- ✓ Statutory and non-statutory public funded organisations/bodies
- ✓ Higher and Further Education Institutions
- ✓ Voluntary/community organisations
- ✓ Small and medium sized enterprises with less than 250 employees
- ✓ Registered charities and Not for Profit organisations

The renewable energy generated should be used by the applicant
